- Enthusiastic participant in community activities

GORDON REID PIONEER BUSINESS AWARD

- Owned & operated same business for 5+ years
- Offers continued good service
- Owner or manager active in the community
- Promotes High Level & area
- Visible in community (ie: sponsorships)

CITIZEN OF THE YEAR

- Outstanding involvement, past & present, in community activities
- Participates beyond the call of duty within the community
- Resident of High Level & region for at least three years

VOLUNTEER OF THE YEAR

- Many years involved in the community helping others
- May be visible in the community but not necessarily
- Participates beyond the call of duty within the community

JUNIOR CITIZEN OF THE YEAR

- Active in extracurricular activities (ie: sports, paper, student union)
- Volunteer work or community involvement
- Helps other people
- Overall enthusiasm for school and community
- Must be 18 years of age or under

SENIOR CITIZEN / COMMUNITY GROUP OF THE YEAR

- Senior citizen must be 55 years of age or older
- Resident or existing group in High Level & area for 3+ years
- Active participant (past & present) in community

FARM FAMILY OF THE YEAR

- Owned and operated viable farm for at least five years
- Community involvement (ie: Rural Crime Watch)
- Shows pride and upkeep of home and farm
- Helps others in the community
